The incubator is located within the University of Palermo campus, covering a total area of about 1,500 square meters and is built around a system of common spaces (coworking areas, a kitchen, a lounge area, printing facilities), units for businesses, offices, staff and meeting rooms, training classrooms and technological laboratories.


We address our action to **students**, **researchers**, **innovators**, to develop their **entrepreneurial potential**.



The PNI aims to spread **business culture in the academic sphere** and to foster the relationship between researchers, the business world and finance.






EIT Health

EIT Health is a consortium of over 140 partners from leading businesses, research centres and universities from across 15 EU countries; it was designated as an EIT Innovation Community by the EIT Governing Board on December 2014.

It's goal is to contribute to increasing the competitiveness of European industry, improve the quality of life of Europe's citizens and the sustainability of healthcare systems.









The InnoStars covers the widest region within EIT Health network, consisting of 14 countries. This area includes the highest concentration of funding for European Structural and Investment Funds (ESIF) for innovation, with €20 billion available up to 2023.








Widening geographical coverage

- New Hubs (5)



Ensuring knowledge transfer towards EIT RIS regions to strengthen innovation ecosystems.









ARCA as EIT Health RIS Hub

CONSORZIO ARCA acted, in 2017, as RIS Coordinator in promoting the EIT Health initiatives.

In 2018 ARCA cooperated in EIT as RIS Hub, and operates on the regional territory to support and accelerate business initiatives in the health sector.

In 2017 6 proposals from the ARCA network were selected for the second phase of the Innostars Award call, winning a € 7,000 grant, and 5 took part in the final event in Naples.

3 companies were selected to access the second phase of the *Catapult 2017* call, winning prizes in the medtech and biotech categories (80K).
